

DCDS was successfully piloted in Greece, Italy, Latvia, Romania and Spain through intensive use by nearly 200 individuals.


Evaluation of the pilots shows that DCDS provides a practical means for the users to develop basic digital competences and increase self-confidence in using digital devices and services.

Digital Competences Development Methodology **DCDM**


Digital Competences Development Environment **DCDE**
